COVID-19 Pandemic Response:

There were no scheduled capital improvements in the last quarter, so the facility has been focusing on the kitchen with minor repairs and replacing bins, carts, dishes, pots/pans etc.

The facility census is 92 with the capacity to hold 120. The facility currently has 17 short-term rehab residents.
