Emergency Care and Transfers

23,000 Emergency Department visits

- 1,024 Transfers (4.4%)
- -16% (196) fewer transfers from previous year

Emergency Department Data – May 29, 2024-May 28, 2025

Medical Reason	# of patients transferred	% of all transfers
Trauma	143	14%
Neuroscience Services	129	13%
Cardiac Care	109*	11%
Behavioral Health	88**	9%
Pediatric	77	8%

* Reduced cardiac transfers by 65% since adding 24/7 STEMI

** 86% of behavioral health transfers were to Guidance Care/Center for substance abuse

Equipment Investments

Replace nuclear medicine camera – Completed April 2025

- Up to 25% reduction in scan time
- Improved image quality
- Greater sensitivity and improved small lesion detection

Replace CT – Fall 2025

- Faster scan times
- Improved image quality
- Enhanced cardiac and vascular testing
- Project Underway

Cardiac Cath Lab investment 24/7

- Transfers for heart care declined from approximately 20 per month to an average of 7 per month



Physical Plant Investments

2024: \$1.5M

- Air Handler Unit (AHU) Replacement at the Depoo Campus
- Exterior Building Paint and Seal
- Fire Pump Replacement at Depoo Campus

2025: \$2.2M

- Underground Fuel Tank Removal
- 4 Air Handler Unit (AHU) Replacements at Main Campus
- Fire Alarm Replacement
- 2 Roof Top Unit (RTU) Replacement at the Depoo Campus
- Main Campus Landscaping and Lighting
- Inpatient Rooms Refresh (Paint, Flooring, Doors, Art)
- Emergency O2 Connection

2026-2028 (Forecasted): \$1.9M

- Exterior Building Paint and Seal at the Depoo Campus
- Replace Boiler
- Replace Steam Generators
- Replace Chiller
- Cooling Tower Expansion
